Stressed, guilt-ridden, and struggling to balance her home, family, and sanity with her multiple roles and responsibilities, she began developing and testing simple, off-beat home-keeping tips. Julie then put pen to paper and shared these tips in *The Accidental Housewife*. Before long, she became a sought-after contributor and go-to gal for home-keeping tips and tricks, appearing regularly on *The Today Show*, *The View*, *Rachael Ray*, *The Doctors*, *Fox and Friends*, ABC Audio Networks and iHeart Radio.
